Language Arts

Reading - Students will be split into groups and working on a play this week. Our emphasis will be on reading fluently and talking with expression. They should be practicing their part every evening. They DO NOT have to be memorized.

Grammar- We will be reviewing all of the parts of speech we have learned already.

Writing- Students will be writing their district writing. We will then be writing in response to reading and working on connecting two stories

Spelling- We will continue to work on words with the oo or ew pattern.

<u>Science</u>

In Science this week, we will continue our Earth's Surface unit. We will be describing how Earth's surface can change rapidly and slowly. We will begin to explore how Earth's surface can change rapidly (earthquakes, volcanoes, and landslides.) We will participate in many hands-on activities to help us explain how earthquakes, volcanoes, and landslides occur.

SOCIAL STUDIES

This week in Social Studies, we continue our Statehood Unit. We will be explaining how Ohio progressed from territory to statehood, including the terms of the Northwest Ordinance. We will explain how the Northwest Ordinance influenced the incorporation of democratic ideals in the states formed from the Northwest Territory. We will also be describing the three step plan to statehood, and reasons people moved to the Northwest territory. We will then begin to describe the impact that settlement had on American Indians, including the Indian Wars, Battle of Fallen Timbers, and the Treaty of Greenville.
