Language Arts

<u>Reading</u> The essential question for the week is, "How do people respond to natural disasters?" Students will cite relevant text evidence and compare and contrast text structure. Vocabulary words are: alter, collapse, crisis, destruction, hazard, severe, substantial, and unpredictable. **There will be a quiz over our main story on Thursday, Sept. 19.**

<u>**Grammar**</u>-Students will identify and write compound sentences.

<u>Spelling</u> - This week we will work on words with the long e pattern. The words are: evening, squeaky, roof, concrete, honey, zebra, healer, deed, scheme, donkey, breathe, sleek, speech, belief, family, league, indeed, wheeze, chief, and weary.

Writing We will continue working on writing friendly letters with an emphasis on the five parts and letter structure.

In Science this week, we will begin our Ecosystem Unit. We will be describing how ecosystems are based on interrelationships between biotic and abiotic factors. We will be building the terrarium part of our ecosystem, and observing and collecting data.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, we will be identifying why we study history and different sources we use to learn about the past. We will identify primary and secondary sources and how we use each of these to learn about the past. Primary and secondary sources will be used all year as we create historical narratives about Ohio's History. We will also begin to construct timelines of significant events in Ohio and the United States. We will be constructing timelines with evenly spaced intervals, events in chronological order, and appropriate titles. Timelines will be used all year as we learn about Ohio's history.
