Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this message finds you well. As we prepare for the upcoming summer camp season at the Boys and Girls Club, we would like to remind you of your responsibility to keep your parent portal updated (email, address, phone numbers, etc.,). The parent portal allows you to manage your child's account, stay up to date on their activities, and make payments for camp fees. You can also stop at the front desk and speak to Kelly Boggs if you can no longer access your account. Payments can be made on the portal or in person, we accept cash, check and card.

The field trips this year are on a first come first served basis, we ask your child to attend no more than two field trips to allow other members to attend them as well. Payments for field trips will need to be made when you sign your member up. The cost of each field trip is included on the summer calendar. The sign-ups will be available the Monday PRIOR to the trip.

Pool day signups will be out the day before and day of, but we will not accept signups the day of after 10am. Pool money will be collected at the time of sign-up as well. Your child's behavior the week prior to any trip will determine if they are able to attend.

Member Discipline Policy

As of June 1, 2024 we will be following this behavior policy. Redirection is necessary for an effective program. We are tolerant and understanding, but we will deal with disruptive behavior in the appropriate manner. The following guidelines have been established. PLEASE NOTE: Any discipline problems that endanger others or are extremely disruptive can result in immediate, temporary suspension until a director/parent conference is held and a behavior plan has been established. Minor offenses are handled by staff and major offenses will be elevated to a director. The progressive guidelines are as follows:

Minor Offenses:

- 1) Verbal Warning
- 2) Written Warning
- 3) Member Meets with the Director
- 4) Director and Parent Conference
- 5) Minimum 1 Day suspension: if issues are reoccurring, they may be asked to remain out longer.

Major Offenses:

- 1) Written Warning (Director Guidance)
- 2) Director and Parent Conference
- 3) 2 Day Suspension
- 4) 3 Day Suspension
- 5) One week suspension/expulsion

While these are a guide for our discipline policy there are some actions that may result in immediate need for suspension. Suspension is for program days and starts the next program day, not including weekends and holidays. Expulsion from the program is for one calendar year unless otherwise notified.

Minor Offenses are considered but not limited to not following directions, name calling/teasing, being disruptive/loud, antagonizing/starting trouble, bringing restricted items, picking on/play fighting.

Major Offenses are considered but not limited to fighting/pushing/kicking, foul language, inappropriate use of electronics, endangering self/others, deceiving/stealing, and going into unauthorized areas.
