Improvement Strategy

Teachers will implement our instructional framework which includes meta analysis high impact strategies of Hattie, Marzano and Depths of Knowledge levels.

College and Career Readiness

Educators will use UDL (universal design for learning) strategies to achieve mastery learning for all students, as statistical significance data indicates a positive impact.

Community, Family Engagement

All buildings will implement Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS), which provides a basis for understanding how educators can work together to ensure equitable access and opportunity for all students to achieve the state standards. MTSS is an integrated, comprehensive framework that focuses on standards, core instruction, differentiated learning, student-centered learning, individualized student needs, and the alignment of systems necessary for all students' academic, behavioral, and social success as statistical significance data indicates a positive impact.

Leadership, Administration, Governance

Southeast Local Schools will involve stakeholders in district planning and continuous improvement practices. Statistical significance data shows that school stakeholders, which includes everyone in the learning community, have a positive impact on young people who experience strong development relationships across different parts of their lives and are more likely to show signs of positive development in many areas, including; increased academic motivation, increased social-emotional growth and learning; increased sense of personal responsibility; and reduced engagement in a variety of high-risk behaviors.
