ELA: We will be reading nonfiction text. Skills include finding the main idea and key details, using Greek roots to determine the meanings of words, and using similes and metaphors to add to our understanding of text.

Beginning in October, students may participate in Pizza Hut's Book It. Information about this reading incentive program will come home soon.

Math: We will be continuing to work through chapter 1 on Data Displays. Students are continuing to work on mean, median, mode, range, and what graphs best suit certain situations. Any notes students take go in their 3 ring binder. We often use earbuds so its important to bring them to class each day. Students finished taking their i-Ready fall benchmark tests last week. We will go over these at conferences.

Science: We will continue to investigate how and where rocks are formed and the three main types of rocks.
