**ELA:** We're off to a great start in language arts! During the week of September 5, students will take the fall i-Ready benchmark test. We will also practice citing text evidence and write letters to our "future selves." During the week of September 12, we will read historical fiction, analyze story elements, and practice using paragraph context clues.

**Math:** Welcome to math class! Students will be starting Unit 1 on Data Displays and Number Systems. In this unit we will be exploring data landmarks such as: mean, median, mode, and range. Graphs students will use include: line graphs, bar graphs, and they will be introduced to histograms. A 3 ring binder will be kept in the room to hold all their notes, papers, and work. They will also have a journal to work out of as well.

**Science:** We will explore how soil formation is based on environmental conditions. Soil forms in layers called horizons. The terms dirt and soil are not the same, use the term "soil".

**Social Studies:** We will explore map tools and the 5 areas of geography.
